Youth Representative Job Description

ELECTION CCYM President and other committee members will be elected at YLC.

ELIGIBILITY Youth elected to the Conference Council on Youth Ministry (CCYM) Steering Committee must be in the seventh (7th) grade through the eleventh (11th) grade in June of the year that they take office. A youth nominated for a CCYM position must be an active member in good standing at a local United Methodist Church youth group.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS Youth nominated for the CCYM Steering Committee must be prepared to attend all Steering Committee meetings. Excused absences may be granted by the CCYM President, who must be notified when absence is foreseen. **Two consecutive absences (excused or unexcused) are considered adequate grounds for recall** since the Steering Committee only meets approximately four times per year.

ELECTED POSITIONS

PRESIDENT

- ⇒ Where the "buck stops"
- ⇒ Convenes and conducts CCYM and Steering Committee meetings.
- ⇒ Responsible (together with Adult Co-Advisors) for deployment of Steering Committee personnel.
- ⇒ Responsible for initiating communications with District/Sub-District, and local church youth leaders.
- ⇒ Represents CCYM as a voting member of Annual Conference session in June of each year.

Other officers (Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer) will be elected at a CCYM Steering Committee Meeting in the summer.

MEMBERS AT LARGE

- ⇒ Serve on assigned CCYM task force groups or design committees e.g., Youth Leadership Conference
